# School and Money

Money is something we don't often talk about but without it, school couldn't run.

For most extra events/ trips etc we offer, we subsidise real costs to parents heavily. For example, the upcoming Llanrug trip is £243 per child for the stay, all activities and coach cost – we have asked parents for £180.

We understand that money is tight in many homes and some very difficult decisions are having to be made, However, school budgets are also increasingly stretched and if parents don't pay their share of these events, then we will not be able to continue them.

If you currently have any outstanding debt on sQuid, please pay this off as soon as possible. Thank-you if you are someone who has recognised your difficulty and got in touch with us—we can put together payment plans. Even something, seemingly small like the payment for swimming adds up for us if no-one pays! It costs us over £350 per week for us to take children swimming.

Please do everything you can to help us to continue to provide brilliant opportunities for our children. If you have financial concerns, then please make an appointment to speak to a senior leader.
