
## **RED NOSE DAY**

All entries need to be in school by 3.15pm on Wednesday 9<sup>th</sup> April for judging. Have fun!

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
## Parent and Child Questionnaire


You will remember we recently sent out questionnaire Forms to every family inviting you to give your views – 58 families did. Thank-you.


Here is a summary of responses. We were pleased how positive they were overall. The 'soft start' to the day was overwhelmingly supported so this will be continued.
